Repeal of Previously Filed By-Laws of the Board of Examination and Registration of Architects

The Board of Examination and Registration of Architects intends to **repeal** previously filed By-Laws of the Board of Examination and Registration of Architects. These By-Laws last refiled on January 4, 2007 (ERLID 2826) have been superseded by the amended Rules and Regulations for the Board of Examination and Registration of Architects which were filed on June 8, 2007 (ERLID 4672).

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws that a public hearing on the repeal of the previously filed By-Laws will be held on Wednesday, December 19, 2007 at 4:00 p.m. in Conference Room B of the William E. Powers Building, 1 Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island, at which time and place all persons interested will be heard.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 42-35-3 of the Rhode Island General Laws, the Board of Examination and Registration of Architects has considered alternative approaches to the repeal of the By-Laws and has determined that there is no alternative approach among the alternatives considered which would be as effective and less burdensome. In addition, the Board of Examination and Registration of Architects has determined that the repeal of the By-Laws will not result in significant adverse economic impact on small business or any city or town.
